AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE ESTABLISHING WATER AND SEWER SERVICE RATES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR ALL SERVICES RENDERED AFTER JANUARY 1, 2012

WHEREAS, the Township annually monitors the financial standing of its water and sewer systems in order that the rates charged for service will be sufficient so that the various systems shall be self sustaining on an ongoing basis; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Chief Financial Officer and Auditor have recommended rate increases for water and sewer so these systems will not run at a deficit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 2012, Section 196-73 of the Mount Olive Township Code is hereby amended to provide the following rates for sanitary sewer within the Cloverhill Sanitary Sewer System:

\$120 per quarter per EDU or Single Family Residential Property or Garden Apartment Unit or \$480 annually

SECTION 2. Commencing January 1, 2012, Section 196-73 of the Mount Olive Township Code is hereby amended to provide that within the Budd Lake Sanitary Sewer System, for all residential structures and for non-residential users that do not have metered service, the following rates for sanitary sewer:

Occupied Property

\$180.50 per quarter per EDU or \$722 annually

Vacant Property

\$138.50 per quarter per EDU or \$554 annually

SECTION 3. Commencing January 1, 2012, Section 196-58.3 of the Mount Olive Township Code is hereby amended to provide the following rates for sanitary sewer within the Wyndham Pointe Sanitary Sewer System:

Occupied Property

\$233 per quarter per EDU or \$932 annually

SECTION 4. Commencing January 1, 2012, Section 196-39, 196-40 and 196-41 of the Mount Olive Township Code are hereby amended to provide that the following rates shall be charged for water service:

Residential Rates

Effective January 1, 2012

- A. Actual metered. Residential consumers of water, except garden apartment consumers, which are subject to Section 196-141, shall be charged quarterly on an actual metered basis at the following rates:
 - (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (flat fee): \$43 per quarter for services rendered on or after the first quarter 2012.
 - (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 22,500 gallons: \$2.34 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (3) Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 37,500: \$3.20 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (4) Thirty-seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons and up: \$4.43 per 1,000 gallons.
- B. Unmetered. Those consumers supplied by Township water systems which are unmetered shall be charged a quarterly flat fee of \$83.64 per quarter for services rendered on or after January 1, 2012.

Effective January 1, 2013

- A. Actual metered. Residential consumers of water, except garden apartment consumers, which are subject to Section 196-141, shall be charged quarterly on an actual metered basis at the following rates:
 - (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (flat fee): \$44 per quarter for services rendered on or after the first quarter 2013.
 - (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 22,500 gallons: \$2.40 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (3) Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 37,500: \$3.28 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (4) Thirty-seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons and up: \$4.54 per 1,000 gallons.
- B. Unmetered. Those consumers supplied by Township water systems which are unmetered shall be charged a quarterly flat fee of \$85.73 per quarter for services rendered on or after January 1, 2013.

Garden Apartment Rates

- A. The water rates for garden apartments, per unit, shall be based on an average meter calculation. Said average meter calculation shall be determined by dividing the total quarterly usage for the entire development by the number of units (determined by certificates of occupancy issued).
- B. The rate schedule per unit for services rendered effective January 1, 2012 shall be as follows:
 - (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (dollars per 1,000 gallons) \$50.25 flat fee.
 - (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred to 22,500 gallons \$2.34 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (3) Twenty-Two Thousand Five-Hundred gallons and up \$3.02 per 1,000 gallons.

Garden Apartment Rates (Continued)

- C. The rate schedule per unit for services rendered effective January 1, 2013 shall be as follows:
 - (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (dollars per 1,000 gallons) \$51.50 flat fee.
 - (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred to 22,500 gallons \$2.40 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (3) Twenty-Two Thousand Five-Hundred gallons and up \$3.10 per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 5. Within the Budd Lake Sanitary Sewer System there are certain non-residential users whose quarterly sewer charges are based upon water meter readings pursuant to Section 2 of Ordinance No. 29-2009. These users for sanitary sewer service will be billed after January 1, 2012 for sanitary sewer service at the following rate:

\$10.14 per 1,000 gallons or \$.01014 per gallon.

(The rate of \$10.14 per 1,000 gallons contains within it an adjustment of 10% for I&I, with a minimum quarterly usage charge of \$209.00)

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2012 for all water and sewer services provided after that date.
