ORDINANCE # 7-2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ADMINSTRATIVE CODE, ARTICLE XX, RULES OF PROCEDURE, SECTION 4-106, MEETINGS, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4, Administrative Code, Article XX, Rules of Procedure, Section 4-106, Meetings, Subsection (A)(2) of the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Chapter 4, Administrative Code, Article XX, Rules of Procedure, Section 4-106, Meetings, Subsection (A)(1) of the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

§ 4-106. Meetings.

- Regular meetings.
- (1) The Council meets every other Tuesday. Exact dates of the meetings can be viewed at the Township's website, www.mountolivetownship.com or by calling the Township Clerk's office at 973-691-0900 Ext. 7290.
- **SECTION 3.** All ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
 - SECTION 5. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
