

***RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
COMMENDING OFFICER ROBERT SCHOLTZ ON HIS 32 YEARS OF SERVICE AND HIS

WHEREAS, as of June 6, 2008, Officer Robert Scholtz completed his required years of service with the Mount Olive Township Police Department and as such retired on that day; and

WHEREAS, Officer Scholtz began working as a Police Officer for the Township of Mount Olive on December 1, 1981, and prior to his sworn police service he served as Special Officer and also worked for nearly 5 years with the Township Road Department; and

WHEREAS, for thirty-two years Officer Scholtz has unselfishly served the citizens of Morris County in a manner that is beyond reproach. Bob has served as a senior officer (Corporal), a detective, and a Communications and Records Division Supervisor. He has always been mechanically adept in the technical aspects of the police radio, computer, and dispatch functions; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure in the Investigations Division, Bob investigated the entire gamut of crimes including homicide, robbery and assaults, but perhaps his greatest expertise was in the discipline of Arson Investigation; and

WHEREAS, Officer Scholtz also provided expertise in motor vehicle law, especially regarding commercial vehicle statutes. Bob is also a weapons expert and firearms instructor. He was also an original Task-Force and Special Operations Unit (SOU) member.

WHEREAS, "Scholtzie" also served the Township for many years as a volunteer fireman with the Budd Lake Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, above and beyond Officer Scholtz's dedicated service he received many commendations and has also earned the a Grand Cordon Ribbon, and Honorable Service Award and a Lifesaving Award; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Mount Olive Township and the members of the Mount Olive Township Police have been fortunate to have such a dedicated officer serve them so well for so long.
